

ENVIRONMENT







One of Indian Centre for Development Right key operational areas is promoting education, in rural areas where resources are limited. A good education system lays a strong foundation, which helps with an overall development of our next generation of youth who play a key role in facilitating growth of our country and our future. In order to make that possible, in the near future we plan on adopting a school and equipping them with resources and creating an education system model, that can be replicated. To promote Education iCFDR run it's owned Project named EASY CLASSES



EDUCATION

We at ICFDR believe even to address issues related with healthcare, poverty, unemployment or human rights, we need to start with Education.

One of a good indicator to measure a country's development is its literacy rate. Although India seems to have made progress in the last decade from 65.38% in 2001 to 74.04% in 2011 in its literacy rates a 9% increase; it appears that the rural areas still tend to be far behind. It could be attributed mainly to poverty, lack of support from the government, as well as lack of priority of education by the caretakers that are raising the youth. In order for all that to change we at iCFDR would like to provide aid to schools in rural areas by helping them with basic infrastructure for schools, equipping schools with good teachers, addition of libraries, computer labs, extracurricular activities (sports, music, sewing, arts), providing electricity using alternative energy. We also plan to collaborate with other NGO's that share our vision and are already working on meeting similar educational needs in certain rural areas but are looking for additional help and support.

India is still home to 17 million child laborers the highest in the world and we at iCFDR believe that poverty, lack of literacy, and lack of importance to education plays a big role in that. In order to strive for a better society we have to begin by changing those variables and creating a generation of youth that continues to take strides in the positive direction.





EMPOWERMENT AND RIGHTS

At iCFDR we think that equality in all walks of life is one of the indispensable factors to development. In order to actualize that thought we want to start by spreading awareness through lectures, workshops and seminars related to human rights, legal rights and right to information.

We look forward to organizing campaigns for raising legal awareness, to help the marginalized sections of the society to better understand their rights and responsibilities. We believe that the key components of basic human rights are equality of gender, female empowerment, child rights, labor rights, welfare of children from vulnerable groups, community empowerment etc.

In order to actualize that thought we want to start by spreading awareness through lectures, workshops and seminars related to human and legal rights. We look forward to organizing campaigns for raising legal awareness, to help the marginalized and oppressed sections of the society to better understand their rights and responsibilities. We believe that the key components of basic human rights are equality of gender, female empowerment, child rights, labor rights, welfare of children from vulnerable groups, community empowerment etc.

We believe that change not only comes from educating and spreading awareness but also from creating an environment where people can have courage to come forward by holding people accountable for their misdoings. We are also working on goverance issues and use of Right to Informantion (RTI) to improve goverance.

Given the current state of affairs we also want to focus on women's safety issues, helping women and children who have been victims of sexual abuse and trafficking, providing aid and support to women suffering from domestic violence and dowry, shelter services for destitute women and children etc. We also plan to collaborate with other organizations that share similar vision as us, that we can support and vice versa.

ENVIRONMENT



iCFDR toils to preserve and improve ecology, so that we and our future generation have chance to experience the magnanimous nature. We work for protection of green cover, spread awareness about global warming, de-forestation, soil erosion, river ecology conservation, animal rights etc.

We also like to promote use of alternate fuels, reusable materials and any such environmental friendly materials. We to plan encourage recycling, proper disposal hazardous products and material. It focuses to encourage alternative sources of electric power and energy. iCFDR creates awareness about pollution control and initiate measures for the same. We at iCFDR aspire to have an overall development with concern for environment.

We are working toward the aim of promoting Environmental Awareness, the nature is the real Earth's Heritage. Welfare of our Earth, its nature and animals is tied up with preservation and Local Community participation is a essential. The air is scarcely breathable, fresh water bodies are choked, trees are cut in the name of development, animal habitats are disturbed on daily basis and jungles are fast disappearing. We work for the concept of Sustainable Development. iCFDR focuses on providing assistance, legal advice and aid for confronting environmental problems. We aspire to involve everyone in the contributing to the betterment of the environment. We work towards creating environmental awareness and raising funds for conservation and other related projects. We work in the field of animal welfare and environment protection.



We believe that medical and health facilities and access in this day and age shouldn't be meager but something that everyone should have accessibility to, which seems to be a challenge in rural areas. We at iCFDR envision reduction in mortality rates resulting from accidents, pregnancy complications, neo-natal and infant mortality by provision of ambulance and emergency services in critical time of need when these services are most needed but its access is limited. ICFDR also plans to raise awareness on maternal health and child health, hygiene, prevention of non-communicable diseases and any other specific disability for example blind children, mental retardation etc. We plan to work hand in hand with the local coordinators in a given community by organizing health camps for medical check up, giving vaccinations, supplying nutritious supplements, delivering informal health care tips in schools and day care centers. ICFDR also plans to raise awareness on maternal health and child health, hygiene, prevention of non-communicable diseases and any other specific disability for example blind children, mental retardation etc. We plan to work hand in hand with the local coordinators in a given community by organizing health camps for medical check up, giving vaccinations, supplying nutritious supplements, delivering informal health care tips in schools and day care centers. We also look forward to collaborating with other agencies that has similar vision as us and are looking for support and vice versa. These kinds of activities help the otherwise ignorant and unaware community by empowering them with knowledge and resources to improve their overall quality of life.

A group of 15 volunteers from iCFDR cleaned the park on 27th March and educated the local authorities on innovative ways to keep and maintain a clean park. The event saw a huge turnout as it was quite popular due to the national context of the campaign in recent years being e supported by the hon'ble Prime Minister Sri Narendra Modi.

Free Water Distribution in Summer

This year during summer iCFDR conducted free water distribution program on 20th May and 17th July. As part of this program, water distribution systems were installed to make free water available for people who were outside their homes travelling for work, etc in scorching summer heat. The event was made successful due to the help provided by volunteers and a few members of iCFDR.




Social Work Leadership Program - Youth Leadership Program






